

PLUGGING METHODS AND PROCEDURE-- The methods and procedure for plugging a well shall be as follows: (a) The bottom of the hole shall be filled to, or a bridge shall be placed at, the top of each producing formation open to the well bore, and in either event a cement plug not less than fifty (50) feet in length shall be placed immediately above each producing formation open to the well bore when ever possible.

(b) A cement plug not less than fifty (50) feet in length shall be placed at approximately fifty (50) feet below all fresh-water-bearing strata.

(c) A plug shall be placed at or near the surface of the ground in each hole.

(d) The interval between plugs shall be filled with heavy-mud-laden fluid.

(e) An uncased hole shall be plugged with heavy mud up to the base of the surface string, at which point a plug of not less than fifty (50) feet of cement shall be placed.

Sorry to have missed you on my recent trip to Farmington. I thought you would be interested in the Federal wells in Mohave County. The Tony Lyons well in Sec. 35, T. 39 N., R. 6 W. has been plugged and abandoned and a marker set. The location is cleared and dressed. There were still two butane tanks on the location, but I'm sure they will be picked up soon. The well is located in close to the foot of the mesa in "badland country" and rather inaccessible. ~~The inclosed picture will give you an idea of how things were left.~~ The State is going to release their bond.

The Western Drilling, located in Sec. 31, T. 38 N., R. 5 W. is another story. According to your files, you have received form 9-330 log and history of well and also subsequent report of abandonment. The State has had no information concerning the abandonment of this well. In fact, the story we get is that they are going to go back in and drill deeper. In field checking this well, I found that the location was cleared and a marker had been set, but I am very suspicious about their plugging. The pit or cellar around the well was not filled, just boarded over. The marker pipe looked like it was sticking through a metal cap on the casing. I took a hold on the marker pipe and was able to shake it, so I am very doubtful about the surface plug which makes me doubtful about the other plugs. The mud pits have not been filled. ~~The inclosed picture shows this.~~ We have written Western to see if we can get a statement of status on this well. If we get any new dope, we will let you know.



Okay Given For Drilling Of Test Well

State permit for the drilling of a synthetic oil well to a basement test in northern Mohave County was issued yesterday to Tony Lyons of Holdenville, Okla.

A stratigraphic test by Lyons and associates had reached a depth of 1,000 feet before the \$2,500 performance bond was filed and the permit issued by the state land department.

Associated with Lyons is Harry Weaver of San Angelo, Tex., among others, who control an estimated 600,000 acres of state, federal, and fee land leases in northern Mohave County.

Your location "990' East of West Line, and 990' North of South Line" would put the well in the NESWSW of the section instead of your description of NESW as is also shown on the plat. 


