The Oil and Gas Conservation Commission has passed a motion requesting your office to bring legal action to forfeit the bonds of each and all of the named operators for failure to comply with the rules and regulations of the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of Arizona relative to the plugging of abandoned wells.

For your assistance the records and reports of the Petroleum Engineer of the Oil and Gas Commission of Arizona show the following to exist:

1. Said applicant obtained a permit to drill and filed a bond in the amount of \$2500 conditioned upon his compliance with the rules and regulations of the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of Arizona and specifically the requirement of plugging wells upon abandonment.
2. That drilling was commenced and thereafter discontinued.
3. That the rig was removed and the operator failed to plug said well as required by the rules and regulations of the Oil and Gas Commission of Arizona.
4. That the above mentioned operator filed an application to plug his well which was approved November 25, 1959, the operation to commence November 23, 1959.
5. That the inspection of the Petroleum Engineer of this Commission has established the fact that such wells were not plugged.
6. That the Petroleum Engineer visited this well location on January 7, 1960. Said operator was notified by form letter on February 25, 1960, of the intent of the Commission to

check all locations and notify the operator where deficiencies existed, that action would be taken to reduce these deficiencies. On April 8, the Petroleum Engineer wrote to Mr. McMillen, asking him to take action with regard to plugging and abandoning this well. To date we have had no reply. The Petroleum Engineer visited the location on June 18, 1960, and there has been no change in well conditions. It is the opinion of the Commission that more than a reasonable length of time has expired within which said well could have been plugged by the operator or have operations resumed.

7. The name and address of the bonding company and agent for the bondsman for said operator is as follows:

It is the request of the Commission, pursuant to motion to that effect unanimously adopted at its meeting of June 22, 1960, that you, as Attorney General of the State of Arizona, file action against said operator, if necessary, but particularly against the bondsman of said operator for the purpose of forfeiting the bond and collecting the penalty thereunder for failure of the operator to comply with the rules and regulations of the Commission to plug the said wells.

There is attached hereto for your information a copy of the form of bond required and which is the same form of bond which has been executed on behalf of the bondsman for the operator. Each of these bonds has been furnished pursuant to the rules and regulations of the Commission and the provisions of Statute 27-516 A3 A.R.S.

Should you desire any further information concerning these matters, please advise us. Will you keep us advised concerning your actions taken thereon?
