





Attached please find information recently furnished to us by Duval Corp., covering its drilling of some forty-four holes in search of potash in Apache County.

As you recall, during the summer of 1964 your company was engaged in potash exploration in this area. Inasmuch as these holes penetrated the Shinarump and Coconino formations, both formations being of potential helium value, I spoke to your personnel engaged in this activity, asking that certain information be filed with this Commission. They felt that this could be done.

This letter is to request you to file information along the line of the information furnished by Duval. Duval has further promised that in the near future they will file copies of logs down to the salt so that the information most valuable to this Commission may be made available to the public.
