For the purpose of this determination attach hereto a neat, accurate plat, map or sketch of this lease, section, block or lot locating thereon the proposed site for this location. Plat shall be drawn to a scale which will permit the facile observation of all pertinent data. Show distances of the proposed well from the two nearest lease and section lines, and from the nearest wells on the same lease completed in or drilling to the same reservoir. If the location requested is not in conformance with the applicable well-spacing rules, show all off-setting wells to the proposed well, and the names and addresses of all adjoining lease or property owners.





Dear Mr. Busby:

In regard to yours of June 17, I regret you're not well physically and hope you overcome it soon.

When I was on the Paulsell ranch, I talked with Mr. Paulsell about the markers on the wells you drilled also the open-ended casing which could easily have caused broken legs among livestock.

At any rate, I more or less tried to anticipate your problems in correction of these discrepancies and asked Mr. Paulsell if he would do it if you asked him to. He said he would consider it and I told him what would satisfy this Commission on the pipe markers of identification. Now, the plugging of the unplugged well will be something else but I feel confident that Mr. Paulsell and I could figure a way for him to accomplish this. Thus, he could take care of your problems involved without you making a trip to the locations.

Now, if this is all right with you, I'd suggest you write Mr. Pat Paulsell about this. I'll explain to him what to do to satisfy the Commission requirements regarding your wells, if you wish.

My brother Tom, (HOR Wichita Falls) spoke very highly of you last September over the telephone, which was the last conversation I ever had with him.
