Gentlemen:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of September 14, 1965 concerning plugging of the captioned well.

Mr. Noonan, whom you stated had been engaged by Mrs. Allen to plug this well, telephoned our office on September 13, 1965 from Winslow. He stated he was prepared to plug this well but was unable to locate the rancher and it was his (Noonan's) intention to return in a week or so to perform this work.

Earlier, on the morning of September 13, Mr. Mike O'Haco was in my office and advised that it was his desire to take over this well as a water well if the hole is straight and suitable for such a conversion. This office agreed to give Mr. O'Haco a reasonable amount of time in which to determine this.

It is the policy of this office to encourage the use of abandoned wells for water wells wherever possible, inasmuch as such usage generally avoids further expenditure of money on the part of the operator and will result in the release of the bond.

In the case at hand, this well must either be taken over by Mr. O'Haco as a water well or be plugged and abandoned. Until such time as one or the other of these actions has been completed, your bond must stay in full force and effect.


Following our letter to you of August 6, 1965, it appeared that our principal, Mrs. Rachel Z. Allen, was going to plug the well in question. In fact she wrote to Mr. Buzz Dobell, one of the men suggested by your Mr. J. R. Scurlock, to oversee this plugging. It is our understanding Mr. Dobell quoted her a price for doing the work and she felt that it was high and has, therefore, undertaken other means to accomplish this.

Since we realize you desire to have the well plugged as soon as possible, we have advised our Houston, Texas, office which has been handling this claim with Mrs. Allen to proceed with the work rather than depend upon her to do it. We assume, therefore, that this will be accomplished shortly since it is our understanding that Mr. Dobell did talk with someone in your office as to exactly how the well was to be plugged and, therefore, has all information he presently needs to proceed.




