Pursuant to your recent request, the following is a recap of operations conducted on the above-captioned well. The Padre Canyon State was spud August 24, 1963 and plugged and abandoned November 19, 1963. Drilling operations were conducted by Lawrence Drilling Company of Farmington, New Mexico. Listed below are the drilling and operational difficulties which were encountered during the drilling of this test well. Loss-circulation was encountered in the Coconino, Supai, and Naco formations. A three-week fishing job was necessary after sticking the drill pipe in the Supai formation at approximately 1700 feet. We were forced to run an intermediate string of 5½" casing at a depth of 2747 feet to combat total loss-circulation. At this point, air was utilized as a circulating medium and our drilling difficulties were remedied.

No shows of oil were encountered until the Devonian-Martin formation was penetrated. The first show was recorded at 3405-20 feet and subsequently drillstem tested. Only drilling fluid was recovered and the bottom-hole flowing and shut-in pressures were 26 lbs. This indicates a lack of permeability; however, these are the first live oil shows of note in Coconino County, Arizona. The second show was located at 3570-75 feet and was not drillstem tested pending electric log interpretation. The interpretation revealed this zone exhibited similar reservoir characteristics to the upper zone and consequently the decision was made not to test this interval. The well was TD'd at a depth of 3596 feet in basement rock.

Although this test was unsuccessful, certainly further exploratory efforts are indicated in this area. The presence of the live oil shows are most encouraging and indicate that the properties you hold in the area could be productive.


