



For the purpose of this determination attach hereto a neat, accurate plat, map or sketch of this lease, section, block or lot locating thereon the proposed site for this location. Plat shall be drawn to a scale which will permit the facile observation of all pertinent data. 



Your letter of December 2 to Mr. Tom P. Stephens of our company has been referred to me regarding your request for information on the Franklin, Aston & Fair, Inc. New Mexico-Arizona Land Company C #1 and C #2, Section 27, Township 18 North, Range 23 East, and the Bernstein #1, Section 36, Township 18 North, Range 23 East.

The New Mexico-Arizona Land Company C #1, 1980 FNL, 1650 FEL, Section 27, T-18N, R-23E, spudded May 28, 1963, reached TD May 29. Copies of the Gamma Ray-Neutron log were forwarded to your office. An attempt to complete was made on June 20, 1963 but the frac treatment damaged the formation and the load was not recovered. The well still continues to produce helium but in a much smaller volume than before treatment. The well was shut in. Attached are the forms No. P-7 for this well.

Our records show that the application to plug and abandon the C #2 well was approved August 13, 1964. There were no logs run in this well but a set of samples was collected and at the request of John Petty were left at the Highway House motel in Holbrook where he planned to pick them up.

The Bernstein State #1, Sec. 36, T-18N, R-23E, was dry and abandoned at 215 feet. Form No. P-7, Well Completion or Recompletion Report and Well Log was approved December 18, 1963 by Mr. John Petty. We did not log this dry hole but a complete set of samples was collected for the State Oil & Gas Conservation Commission as requested by Mr. Petty. The plugging report was approved November 27, 1963. If these records have been lost, we would be happy to supply you with Photostat copies from our files.

We are in receipt of your letter of November 6, 1964, requesting permission to cancel the captioned bond covering all of your wells in the State of Arizona.


