

Eastern Petroleum has abandoned 1 New Mexico-Arizona Land, c 5-16n-25e, Apache County, Arizona. Total depth is 682 ft. Coconino was logged at 616 ft. A drillstem test of the formation 620-630 ft recovered 110 ft of water. Water was also recovered on tests of Coconino perforations 620-640 ft. Three miles to the southeast, Eastern is drilling at 380 ft at 2 New Mexico-Arizona Land, c 15-16n-25e, a scheduled 900 ft test of Coconino. Eastern has made location for 3 New Mexico-Arizona Land, c 9-16n-25e, about midway between the two. It also is to test Coconino.
