
Dear Mr. Bannister:

Enclosed are Applications for Permit to Drill for Kerr-McGee Mineral Strat Tests #4 through #9. On April 24 we mailed Applications for Permit to Drill on Strat Tests #1, 2, 3 and 10. Attached to each enclosed Application is a check in the amount of \$25.

On each Application enclosed, as well as those already in your hands, is the well location given in footage from section lines. I find after talking to our Surveyor, Mr. J. G. Martinez, that in some cases he will be unable to stake the location to conform exactly with the footage on our Application. This change would be due to the desired location falling in a stock tank, feeding area or some other cultural obstacle. The footage that appears on the plats which Mr. Martinez will forward directly to you will be the location where we propose our Strat Test. If you would be kind enough to make any adjustments on our application form from the plats you will receive from Mr. Martinez, we would be greatly indebted.

The staking of the locations is progressing much slower than I had anticipated. I hope, however, that Mr. Martinez will be able to send to you plats for the four Applications now in your office within a very few days. After I think that they have arrived, I will contact you to determine whether permission to proceed with the program has been approved.
