Call From Blackie McClelland this date. He advised me that one of the offending pits that had been seeping salt water had been emptied and that the other offending pit was in the process of being emptied. He also said that he had submitted Form 25 (mailed 12-10-70) requesting permission to inject produced water into the Humble E-2 Navajo. — 444

He also requested permission to comingle production from the Globe wells into the AAA well. He was told to submit all the information on these leases and we would consider his request.

Blackie further related that he had received the assignment on the Globe leases from the Navajo Tribe; and, that all the details of transferring these leases to AAA had been cleared. AAA is the total interest holder of these leases.

Blackie McClelland telephoned this date requesting permission to inject water from #483, 509, and 511, into the Humble #E-2, Permit #444. Approximately 400 barrels per day is being injected currently and he anticipates approximately 600 to 700 additional barrels will be involved. The Commission Order of July 10, 1968, permits a maximum of 1,000 barrels per day estimated; however, inasmuch as the Commission's figure is based upon an estimate, this amount would not be objectionable. The maximum amount of water that could be put in this formation is desirable.

Mr. McClelland was instructed to send in a Form 25 on the two wells, #483 and #509, which will be tied in for injection purposes.

In addition, he advised he desires to re-enter the Globe #1 Navajo, #508 and requested that Applications to permit same be ~~sent~~ sent to him.



David Conn called me at my residence on 7-23-69, mid-afternoon. This was in response to a letter that I had written to Jacobs and given a copy to Conn. Conn assured me as an officer of the company, that we were to look to Jacobs for fulfillment of all regulations pertaining to the wells. Jacobs acts with the consent and knowledge of the officers of the company.

We have on hand a \$25 check which is meant to be the permit fee for a well to be drilled in the NW/4 NE/4 of Section 5, T41N, R28E. They are sending in all of the material necessary to complete this application. These requirements were enumerated in our letter dated July 24, 1969.

Mr. Conn indicates that he will apply for a state-wide bond, \$25,000, which will allow the other bonds to be released on establishment of that state-wide bond. He indicated that we should have telegraphic notification of this state-wide bond today.

Conn indicated that the lease-hold interest on the Globe Minerals AAA / #E-3 well is held by Globe Minerals. The lease number now bears the suffix 597-A indicating an assignment out of AAA into Globe that has been authorized by the Navajo Tribe.

I discussed with him briefly the desire of AAA for an unorthodox well site. He indicated that there was no objection on the part of Globe Minerals. Globe Minerals will be circulated on the Notice for Hearing, however, and will be given the opportunity to lodge official objection or complaint.

The conversation was a pleasant discourse.

Dear Blackie:

On December 1, 1970, I had occasion to visit your leases in the East Boundary Butte Field. There are no signs on your batteries. This is in violation of ARS Section 27-516 Paragraph A-8, a copy of which is enclosed.

Of a much more serious nature is the seepage occurring from several of the pits you are using to contain produced salt water. Since the tank batteries have no identifying signs, I am unable to point out the offending pits, however, they are easily identified. All that is necessary is to drive around the south side of the pits.

The water seeping from these offending pits has traveled several hundred feet from the storage ponds. Stock are much in evidence around these seeps; and, the water is destroying the vegetation.

You are strongly urged to take the necessary measures to inject this produced water into the injection well that you have access to instead of attempting to use these storage ponds. If this is not feasible at this time, we insist that you do whatever is required to the above situation to put a halt to these conditions immediately. See Rule 307 Section A which is enclosed.
