The permit for this well was originally issued for the well to be drilled 1650' FSL & FWL of Sec 21-T21N-R28E, Apache County.


Permit issued on October 18, 1971. On November 8, 1971 a Sundry Notice was received in this office requesting a change of location. The reason given for this change was that the original location was too close to a dwelling. The requested change located the Chambers No. 1 as follows: 2310 FSL & 1650 FWL, Sec 21-21N-28E. A revised Form 4 reflecting this change of location was received November 18, 1971. Holes were spudded at each location. The operators claimed the first location was drilled as a water well. The 5½" csg. is open in this hole. Water is standing some 100' from surface. There is wire line, pipe and misc. junk on this location. The other hole is shut-in. No pressure on well. The reserve pit is still open. The leasee, Mr. Tom Pelton, has expressed a desire to take over both wells as water wells.





Dear Mr. Edwards:

According to your recent note you indicated that you were unaware of the location of Mr. Pelton's land. For your information, the above well was drilled on Pelton's place. When the permit for this well was originally filed the legal description was given as 1650' FSL & 1650' FWL, Sec 21-T21N-R28E. Your firm later requested this location to be changed to 1650' FWL & 2310' FSL, same section, township and range. This location was approved. Both these locations had holes drilled on them.

Mr. Fullop had informed me by Sundry Notice, Form 25, dated 11-5-71, that because the original location was too close to an inhabited dwelling, Pelton's residence, the owner requested the well site to be moved. However, Mr. Fullop had said that an attempt was made at drilling a water well at the location. These are the two locations that Mr. Pelton has expressed a desire to assume responsibility of. Your Sanders No. 2, as you well know, was drilled over a mile to the northeast of these Chambers locations and on property owned or leased by others.

We have received Mr. Edward's letter dated March 12, 1974 together with Form 25, Sundry Notice and Reports, on 16 wells in the Navajo Springs area. We are aware that a number of your wells are in the Navajo Springs Coconino Unit. According to our records, several of the wells that are in the Unit have never produced except during testing and are being carried as shut-in helium wells. A number of wells outside the Unit have never produced, and your completion reports indicate the production on the potential test to be zero or TSM. Other wells have been taken off production for various reasons.

The possibility of some of these wells ever being produced commercially again appears negligible. As you know, Western Helium has not taken gas from your wells since December 31, 1973. This company is now in the process of dismantling and moving their plant out of the area. There is a possibility that Kerr-McGee might arrange to take gas from some of the wells in the Navajo Springs Unit as they are now doing from your Santa Fe No. 13 and Barfoot.

It is the opinion of this Commission that all non-commercial wells in the Navajo Springs area, whether in the Unit or not, should be permanently plugged and abandoned as quickly as possible. These wells would include, within the Navajo Springs Coconino Unit, the Crest Santa Fe No. 2, Santa Fe Nos. 31 and 32, and the Reese No. 2. No production has been reported from any of these wells. Also to be plugged should be your Ancon Santa Fe Nos. 21 and 21-1A, Connelly KM State No. 1, Merde No. 1 and all the non-producers that have been drilled within the past three years. Your Merde No. 2 must be plugged immediately. The hole in the casing at approximately 750' has never been repaired and the well is flowing water. Also your Dreck No. 1 has been reported plugged and abandoned, a copy of your plugging report is attached. It is possible that this well has been partially plugged, however there is definitely no plug in the top of the casing and fluid is several hundred feet from the surface. The dry hole marker was never installed. It is on

location but the casing had a bucket inverted over the open end. The hole you drilled on the original location for the Chambers No. 1 for a "water well" is open with wire line and other junk around the open hole. Mr. Tom Pelton, the owner or holder of the surface rights of the land on which the two Chamber holes are located has expressed the desire to assume responsibility of both the holes for water wells. Mr. Pelton's address is P. O. Box 7, Sanders, Arizona 86512, phone: (602) 688-2930. Our Form No. 24, when executed by Mr. Pelton, will satisfy our requirements. Also Wayne Wallace has some interest in some of the holes on his place for use as water wells.

Recently we found a well some 700' + in a northerly direction of the Merde No. 2, a copy of a photograph is attached. We have no records of a well being drilled at this location. Any information that you could give us on this well would be appreciated. It is being used as a water well.

Either Mr. Bannister or myself will be happy to discuss the above mentioned situation with you. However, we are determined to have the existing conditions in the area brought into complete compliance with the rules and regulations of the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission in the very near future.

We would appreciate your thoughts on the above.






