Plan is to plug above the caved in quick sand-clay block. This block exists of almost cemented sand-clay from a cavity source of over 100 ft thick at about the 690 ft to 800 ft zone. It came up the hole and perhaps goes to almost bottom and required re-drilling hole if we wished to log or test.

Hence, we wish to cement, using neat cement, from the point of bit blockage up into the conductor casing. Perhaps 50 ft plug.

Then, since the mud now stands at about 50 from top of casing, we wish to run top cement plug from mud level to top of hole and set 4" pipe marker as required.

Mr. Mac Donald called today for plugging authorization. The well is to be plugged with 50' cement plug in the bottom of the hole, 100' plug from 450' to 350', and 20' plug top of the surface pipe with regulation dry hole markers. Heavy mud is to be placed between plugs.

After resuming operations following the Holidays, they were unable to get back to the original total depth of 3986'. There was some 800' of fill-up in the hole and the hole kept sluffing.


I just returned back here on the 26th.


I apologize for the long delay in replying to your letter addressed to me at Lindsay, California, dated January 28, 1972.
