You might be interested in my analysis of the cuttings from the P. & H. Development No. 1 Federal, section 30, T. 2 S., R. 9 W., Maricopa County, Arizona:

0-30 feet	Alluvium (Granite wash)
30-130 feet	Siltstone, red and gray, with minor sandstone, arkosic.
130-180 feet	Limestone, gray and brown, with petroliferous zones, interbedded with siltstone and sandstone, gray to red.
180-250 feet	Sandstone and siltstone, gray to red, arkosic, with conglomerate, reddish.
250-270 feet	Siltstone, red, with basal red conglomerate.
270-1690 feet	Gneiss, gray to white, coarsely-crystalline, with several interbedded phyllitic zones. Well appears to have cut several pegmatites, as well as several fracture zones marked by limonitic staining.
1690-1710 feet	No samples. TD 1710 feet.

This well was drilled by cable-tools in 1973, and sample quality is good. Several oil shows were reported, the best supposedly being between 840-845 feet, in gneiss. William Allen, Arizona Oil and Gas Commission, reports that he observed a small show of gas when the bailer was pulled from 1675 feet, also in gneiss. These shows in gneiss, if accurate, are difficult to explain. If they actually exist, then it must be assumed that the shows occur in fractures.

Capt. Thomas Howell, U.S. Air Force pilot, and amateur uranium prospector, has a sensitive scintillometer. He reports that he obtained a strong count at a small road cut within sight of the P. & H. well location. He says the count is in petroliferous limestones. I did not observe this road cut, but have no reason to doubt its existence.

Mr. Francis Sousa and I taped-out an approximate stratigraphic section in a dry wash 1/4 mile east of the P. & H. well. The measured section agrees almost exactly with the section encountered in the well. We examined two localities in the area where the Tertiary sediments are lying on the gneiss with a basal conglomerate. The gneissic surface is deeply weathered and is irregular. The Tertiary sediments appear to be residual patches upon the gneiss, just as mapped by the Arizona Bureau of Mines. There is absolutely no evidence that the Tertiary is older, and that it represents "fensters" in an overthrust sheet. The Tertiary sediments are complicated by normal faulting in places, but we saw no evidence of major thrust-faulting on the surface.

According to Mr. Frazer the contributors, with the permission of Lou Purigraski, have formed a committee to evaluate the possibilities of attempting to complete this hole. Frazer is chairman of this committee. The other two members are Evan Hobb and Manny Moris. Their tentative plans are to run radioactivity survey and selectively perforate the 7" casing that is now in the hole. I informed Mr. Frazer that unless the 7" casing was adequately cemented in the hole, they would learn absolutely nothing by perforating this pipe. I strongly urged Mr. Frazer to seek the services of a qualified petroleum engineer before spending any more money on this well.

Gentlemen:

A one gallon glass container of drilling fluid, labeled "980-985", was submitted to us for determination of hydrocarbon gas. The container was approximately one-half full of fluid and sealed with tape.

Two samples were extracted and analyzed through our gas chromatograph.

Very small twin peaks occurred on the chromatogram, as methane and ethane, in each sample.

The approximate concentration was less than one per cent of each gas.

No odor was found upon opening of the sample container.

From this test, we would conclude that only trace amounts of gas were present in this submitted sample. However, the method of sampling was crude and procuring of the sample from the bailer into the sample container may have flashed any gas into the atmosphere.

Gentlemen:

Three samples of drilling fluid, clay base, were submitted to us March 4, 1972 for identification or presence of hydrocarbons.

We found traces of hydrocarbon in the solvent extract of each sample.

The sample from 840-845 exhibited the strongest trace.

The procedure used was to take a measured amount of sample, add a measured amount, approximately twenty per cent by volume, of solvent, carbon tetrachloride was used, shake vigorously and extract the solvent into a clean container.

This extract was then examined under an ultraviolet lamp.

All samples produced a yellow fluorescence which is indicative of the range of excitation of crude petroleum.

Other than the inspector, no one was present at the well site. The rig had been moved out, and it was not apparent where the well had been drilled.

The well site covers an area of about 1½ acres. It was a big mess with scattered equipment. This included: A trailer, a cable tool bit, an old ice box, several joints of 7"± casing, barbeque made of native rock, empty drums, 2 LPG tanks, 10 sacks cement with 2 broken, old car battery, 5' x 30' sump about 3' deep with mud in bottom, four 8" x 8" x 8' timbers, one 3' x 3' x 10' steel rack, old machine parts, a John Deere tractor with dozer on front and plow on the back. Also scattered over the site was miscellaneous garbage.

There was also a water well with an operating windmill enclosed in a cyclone fence. This had a sign reading - "Sportsmen - This development was constructed for your game with your money. Help protect your investment. Arizona Game and Fish Department".

I thought that the Lou-Federal # 1 well had been converted to a water well, however Mr. Donald F. Russell says the water well was there during drilling of Lou-Federal # 1, and there is a possibility that the Lou-Federal # 1 was covered to protect it from vandals. According to Mr. Russell, the operator plans to move in rotary rig and drill deeper.

Mr. Savoy has indicated his intention to proceed in having the oil well properly abandoned and plugged according to the requirements of the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission. It was indicated that this operation should be completed prior to the date of July 15, 1974.



I attempted to call you this morning only to learn that you were back in the hospital. I surely hope that your stay will be a short one and that you will soon be all OK.

I visited your well location yesterday, April 2, 1973, and frankly things have been left in a great mess. There are innumerable hazards to both humans and livestock. The present condition of this well and location is in direct conflict with the Rules and Regulations of the Arizona Oil and Gas Conservation Commission.

Please refer to Rule 202, Section B, which states, in effect, that when drilling has been suspended for 60 days, the well must be plugged.

The working pit is open creating a hazard to humans, livestock, and game animals. The cesspool at the trailer site is not filled. The cover on this cesspool is extremely fragile and could create quite a problem. There is junk and equipment of various kinds scattered about. All of the above mentioned discrepancies must be corrected as soon as possible.

In addition to the above mentioned items, before this well can be considered to be in compliance with the Commission's Rules and Regulations, we must have a full set of samples, copies of all logs run on this well, including the driller's log.

Since you are confined to the hospital, we are reluctant to demand that you bring this operation into compliance with our Rules and Regulations, however, it is our feeling that we must urge you, for your own protection, to take whatever action you or your associates can take to correct the existing condition.
