


We appreciate the opportunity to comment in advance of the State's issuance of drilling permits for oil and gas exploration in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 36, T. 20 N., R. 19 W., G&SRM. Prior to entry, the mineral developer may be required to obtain rights-of-way from the Bureau of Land Management when surface disturbing activities such as road construction, pipeline installation, and on-site facilities development are involved.

Title V of the Federal Land Policy and Management Act of 1976 (P.L. 94-579, 90 stat. 2743) provides the Bureau of Land Management with the authority to grant rights-of-way over, upon, or through public lands. The Act defines the term "public lands" as any land and interest in land owned by the United States and administered by the Secretary of Interior through the Bureau of Land Management. Applications for rights-of-way should be submitted to the Bureau of Land Management, State Director - 943, Arizona State Office, 2400 Valley Bank Center, Phoenix, Arizona 85073 and should be filed in accordance with subpart 2800, Title 43 of the Code of Federal Regulations.

The Bureau of Land Management will assess potential environmental impacts resulting from the anticipated action and will determine what stipulations are necessary to lessen or avoid damage to resource values. We have also enclosed, for your information, maps depicting proposed wilderness study areas within the State of Arizona. These study areas have been determined by the Bureau of Land Management as having wilderness characteristics and are currently being studied to determine whether each area is suitable for preservation as wilderness.

We are very interested in attaining a good working relationship with the Conservation Commission and hope to maintain a good avenue of communication. If we, in the Kingman Resource Area, can be of further assistance, please give us a call at 757-4011.
