MEMORANDUM

Subject: Plugging of Well No. 1-28, Lease A-17726, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 28,  
T. 18 N., R. 4 E.

On Wednesday, August 10, 1988, Golden Sun Investments Limited plugged the subject well. Surface casing is 8-5/8", set at 153', and cemented. Production casing is 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", set at 1453', and cemented. Total depth was 1490' and plugged back to 1430'. The production casing was perforated at the following intervals: 1335'-1315', 1215'-1205', 1198'-1192' and 1162'-1152'.

The plugging operation began at 9:30 a.m. Equipment on site consisted of a transit mixer, with approximately 6 cubic yards of class A cement, cement pump, cable tool rig and backhoe. Cement was pumped through 2" tubing which was initially set at approximately 1100' from surface. Cement was pumped through the tubing until bumped. Tubing was pulled at 300' intervals between placement of the cement. The entire production casing was plugged with cement from bottom to surface. The surface and production casing was cut 3' below surface and then capped with concrete. A good plugging job was obtained.

The surface was then reshaped, scarified, water bars added and reseeded as prescribed by the U.S. Forest Service. Little actual disturbance (1/5 acre or less) is evident at the site as considerable native vegetation has already reestablished itself from the time the well was completed (October 1982) to present.

Operations were completed by approximately 3:00 p.m.

#### CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

##### Plugging of Well

1. A continuous cement plug shall be placed from the bottom of the hole (1486) to a minimum of 50 feet above the top perforation (1098).
2. A cement surface plug of at least 50 feet shall be placed. The top of the plug shall be placed as near the eventual casing cut-off point as possible.
3. The interval between the cement plugs shall be filled with mud with a minimum weight of 9 pounds per gallon.  

In lieu of placing mud, you may choose to carry a continuous cement plug from the bottom of the well bore to the surface.
4. All casing shall be cut off at least 3 feet below the final restored ground level and the casing filled from the cement plug to the surface with cement, sand or gravel. The well bore must then be covered with a metal plate at least 1/4-inch thick, welded in place, or a cement cap extending at least 12 inches beyond the longest diameter pipe and at least 4 inches thick.
5. The BLM shall be notified a minimum of 24 hours prior to the plugging of the well.
6. (Your proposal to get the bottom plug of the well by allowing a gravity drop of the cement from the surface is unacceptable.)

##### Surface Reclamation Requirements

1. All wood and debris shall be removed from the well site.
2. Check dams, spaced approximately 10 feet apart, shall be placed across the small ditch which leads from the well bore to existing pit.
3. The pit shall be closed with materials that came from the hole and reshaped to blend in with the natural terrain. The disturbed area shall be left in a serrated condition rather than smooth to discourage water runoff.
4. Hand rake the sand pile of drill waste.
5. Sand dropseed shall be broadcast over the disturbed areas and then lightly dragged.
6. All equipment used on the job will have the proper spark arrestor or baffled muffler.
7. The access road should not require work to get the equipment into the site. If this changes, please notify the Arizona BLM at (602) 241-5507.







## Hartwell Canyon is priceless to nature buff

**H**artwell Canyon, one of the newest preserves acquired by The Nature Conservancy in Arizona, intrigued me. I had never heard of it, and I've been around awhile.

I asked Bob Erb, new Central Arizona representative for TNC, about visiting Hartwell. We planned an exploratory hike to the remote canyon west of Oak Creek in the Red Rock country.

The Nature Conservancy recently received Hartwell as a gift from Bob and Mary Kittredge of Sedona with the provision that the Kittredges may continue to live in their home at the mouth of the canyon as long as they live.

Hartwell is a gem for several reasons, most importantly as a wildlife area because it harbors a substantial nesting population of peregrine falcons in the white cliffs that rim the upper canyon walls. It has some unusual Indian ruins and beautiful rock carvings.

Fifty acres were homesteaded in the early 1900s by Charles Rysinger, blocking off the mouth of the canyon. It received its name because a man named Hart dug an 80-foot well for Rysinger's 400 head of

cattle. The water had so much petroleum in it cattle wouldn't drink it.

Rysinger sold the 50 acres to Sam and Minnie Hunter of Missouri during the Depression for something like \$400. Hunter raised hogs in Missouri and hoped to do the same in Arizona. When he got to the little rock cabin at the mouth of Hopewell Canyon, he found nothing to feed hogs and no chance of a slop route.

Kittredge knocked on his door one night. Kittredge was trying to recruit members for the old Verde Valley Electric Co-op for \$5 so power could be brought to the rural residents of Verde-Sedona.

Hunter's response was that he wouldn't

"put another nickle into this worthless place, let alone \$5," and if he could just get his money out of it he would go back to Missouri to raise hogs. Kittredge paid \$600 for the 50-acre homestead. That was 50 years ago.

The Kittredges loved the canyon and set about building a place to live.

Everything was about finished when Kittredge realized he was 77 years old, and when the U.S. Forest Service tried to acquire the 50 acres so Hartwell Canyon could be turned over to ORVs, he started worrying about what would happen to the canyon after he and his wife were gone. That's when someone told him about how The Nature Conservancy acquires and preserves areas vital to wildlife.

The Canyon is a haven for mountain lion, bear, deer, small game and birds. It also has a wide variety of plants. We even found a Douglas fir among the pinon, juniper, oak and ponderosa pine. Water is scarce, but there is a spring-fed pool near the mouth of the 4-mile-long canyon.

A firm's conservative appraisal valued the 50-acre worthless homestead at \$750,000. For a nature buff, it is priceless.



A review of our files concerning your Well No. 1-28, Federal Lease A-17726, Yavapai County, Arizona, which was spudded on or about September 23, 1982, reveals that there has been no activity on this well since November 1982. The Bureau of Land Management requires that wells which are not capable of producing oil and gas in paying quantities be plugged and abandoned unless you can justify keeping the well in a temporarily abandoned status. This justification should include a schedule for performing engineering analysis, testing, reworking, or other action to develop the well for beneficial use.

Advance notice of the plugging operation is requested so a BLM representative may witness the work.

Also, inspection of our records indicates that the following reports pertaining to Well No. 1-28 have not been submitted:

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- Two copies of electronic logs as required by 43 CFR, Part 3162.4-1.
- Geologic Report as required by 43 CFR, Part 3162.4-2.

Please submit these reports to Paul Buff of this office within 30 days upon receipt of this letter.

Failure to submit the requested reports within the time specified may result in the assessment of penalties in accordance with 43 CFR, Part 3163.3.


